## TRAILS BUILT IN 2004

- 1 **Richmond Redevelopment Agency (RRA):**  
Lucretia Edwards Park
- 2 **Toll Brothers, Inc:**  
Seacliff Drive & east end of Brickyard Cove Rd
- 3 **City & TRAC:** Boat Ramp St access to Santa Fe Channel off Cutting Blvd

## TRAILS TO BE BUILT IN 2005-2006

- 4 **West Contra Costa Sanitary Landfill:**  
South & West side levees
- 5 **City:** Gap in Richmond Parkway Bay Trail between Pennsylvania and Gertrude Avenues
- 6 **City:** Ferry Point tunnel trail widening and illumination
- 7 **City & TRAC:** Gap along Canal Blvd north of Seacliff Drive
- 8 **RRA:**  
Harbour Way South from Hall Ave to Hoffman Blvd
- 9 **Orton Development, Inc :** Historic Ford Assembly Building shoreline and frontage on Harbour Way

- 10 **Pt San Pablo Yacht Harbor:** Shoreline & breakwaters

## PLANNING/DESIGN PRIORITIES 2005

- 11 **EBRPD:** Pt. Pinole Regional Shoreline south to Richmond Parkway at Goodrick Ave
- 12 **TRAC:** Ensure that Bay Trail is included in plans for lands between San Pablo Creek & Pt Pinole Regional Shoreline
- 13 **West County Wastewater District & EBRPD :** Wildcat Creek Regional Viewpoint to San Pablo Creek, Landfill and Richmond Parkway
- 14 **Upstream LLC:** : Trails and parks at Point Molate
- 15 **City, EBRPD, Coastal Conservancy, Muir Heritage Land Trust & ChevronTexaco:** Bay Trail spur as part of a regional park on western side of San Pablo Peninsula from I-580 north to Pt. San Pablo Yacht Harbor
- 16 **Toll Brothers & RRA:** Ferry Point to Seacliff Estates
- 17 **City & Port of Richmond:** Access to WWII Homefront National Historical Park sites in historic Kaiser Shipyard 3 connecting Canal Blvd. & Brickyard Cove Road
- 18 **Cherokee Simeon Corporation:** Trail connections with Campus Bay Project west of 51st St
